Acts 1 ⁴ And while being in their company and eating with them, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem but to wait for what the Father had promised, Of which [He said] you have heard Me speak. [John 14:16,26; 15:26.] ⁵ For John baptized with water, but not many days from now you shall be baptized with (placed in, introduced into) the Holy Spirit. ⁸ **But you shall receive power** (ability,

efficiency, and might) **when the Holy Spirit has come upon you**, and you shall be My witnesses in Jerusalem and all Judea and Samaria and to the ends (the very bounds) of the earth. AMP

Acts 2 ¹ AND WHEN the day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all assembled together in one place, ² **When suddenly there came a sound from heaven like the *rushing* of a violent tempest blast, and it filled the whole house in which they were sitting.** ³ And there appeared to them tongues resembling fire, which were separated and distributed and which settled on each one of them. ⁴ And **they were all filled** (diffused throughout their souls) **with the Holy Spirit and began to speak** in other (different, foreign) languages (tongues), as the Spirit kept giving them clear and loud expression [in each tongue in appropriate words]. AMP

1 Corinthians 14 ² For one who speaks in an [unknown] tongue speaks not to men but to God, for no one understands or catches his meaning, because **in the [Holy] Spirit he utters secret truths and hidden things [not obvious to the understanding]**. ¹⁴ For if I pray in an [unknown] tongue, my spirit [by the Holy Spirit within me] prays, but my mind is unproductive [it bears no fruit and helps nobody]. ¹⁵ **Then what am I to do? I will pray with my spirit [by the Holy Spirit that is within me], but I will also pray [intelligently] with my mind and understanding;** I will sing with my spirit [by the Holy Spirit that is within me], but I will sing [intelligently] with my mind and understanding also. ¹⁸ I thank God that I speak in [strange] tongues (languages) more than any of you or all of you put together; AMP

Jude 20 ²⁰ But you, beloved, build yourselves up [founded] on your most holy faith [make progress, rise like an edifice higher and higher], **praying in the Holy Spirit;** AMP

1 Corinthians 5 ⁷ Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are *in fact* unleavened. **For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed.** ⁸ **Therefore let us celebrate the feast,** not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth. NASU

1 Corinthians 10 ¹⁶ The cup of blessing [of wine at the Lord's Supper] upon which we ask [God's] blessing, does it not mean [that in drinking it] we participate in and share a fellowship (a communion) in the blood of Christ (the Messiah)? The bread which we break, does it not mean [that in eating it] we participate in and share a fellowship (a communion) in the body of Christ? ¹⁷ **For we [no matter how] numerous we are, are one body, because we all partake of the one Bread** [the One Whom the communion bread represents]. AMP

1 Corinthians 11 ²³ For I received from the Lord Himself that which I passed on to you [it was given to me personally], that the Lord Jesus on the night when He was treacherously delivered up and while His betrayal was in progress took bread, ²⁴ And when He had given thanks, He broke [it] and said, **Take, eat. This is My body, which is broken for you. Do this to call Me [affectionately] to remembrance.** ²⁵ Similarly when supper was ended, He took the cup also, saying, **This cup is the new covenant [ratified and established] in My blood. Do this, as often as you drink [it], to call Me [affectionately] to remembrance.** ²⁶ **For every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are representing and signifying and proclaiming the fact of the Lord's death until He comes [again].** AMP
