### Excerpt from Chuck Pierce Email – March 11, 2020

*During that Head of the Year 5780 gathering on September 26-29, 2019, I began to prophesy that the nations would come into turmoil until Passover. At Starting the Year Off Right 2020, God was saying that there would be a massive plague-like invasion that would test us through Passover. "God has put a PAUSE until He sees who is willing to cross over with Him through His blood at Passover." This Passover will become a dividing line for our future!*

### Chuck Pierce - March 30, 2020

I started prophesying last September that this year would be a "**True Passover.**" Even though we have celebrated many Passovers, the Spirit of God said this would be the year that we would really have to understand Passover. He said plague-like conditions would hit the earth, and February, March and April would be hellish. But He was looking at nations to see which nations "**PASSED OVER.**" I then began to see that the real issue would be an economic rearrangement throughout the world.

I see that if we celebrate and honor His Blood, the death structure that is gripping these nations will shift at Passover. I see that death toll in the nations that celebrate and honor His Blood and acknowledge Him will start decreasing after Passover. But remember, once the Israelites passed over they still had 40 days to press through into their promise. They had great problems during that 40-day period, and postponed their promise for 40 years. I decree that during this 40-day period there will be no postponement. This is exactly what the Spirit of God said to me and what I have been saying since September.

Take heart - we will make it through!

**1 Corinthians 5** <sup>7b</sup> For **Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed.** <sup>8a</sup> Therefore **let us celebrate the feast,** NASU

**Exodus 12** <sup>14</sup> 'Now this day will be a memorial to you, and you shall **celebrate it as a feast to the Lord;** throughout your generations you are to celebrate it **as a permanent ordinance.** NASU

**Deuteronomy 16** <sup>16</sup> "Three times in a year all your males shall appear before the Lord your God in the place which He chooses, at the **Feast of Unleavened Bread** and at the Feast of Weeks and at the Feast of Booths, and **they shall not appear before the Lord empty-handed.** <sup>17</sup> "**Every man shall give as he is able,** according to the blessing of the Lord your God which He has given you. NASU

## Four Dividing Line Pauses and Passovers

**Exodus 3** <sup>3</sup> So Moses said, "I must turn aside now and see this marvelous sight, why the bush is not burned up." <sup>4</sup> When the Lord saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am." <sup>7</sup> The Lord said, "I have surely seen the affliction of My people who are in Egypt, and have given heed to their cry because of their taskmasters, for I am aware of their sufferings." <sup>8</sup> "So I have come down to deliver them from the power of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a good and spacious land, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanite and the Hittite and the Amorite and the Perizzite and the Hivite and the Jebusite. NASU

**God brought them out of the curse to bring them into the blessing.**

**1. Exodus 12** <sup>3</sup> "Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying, 'On the tenth of this month they are each one to take a lamb for themselves, according to their fathers' households, a lamb for each household.' <sup>7</sup> 'Moreover, they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses in which they eat it.' <sup>11</sup> 'Now you shall eat it in this manner: with your loins girded, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and you shall eat it in haste — it is the Lord's Passover.' <sup>13</sup> 'The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.' <sup>14</sup> 'Now this day will be a memorial to you, and you shall celebrate it as a feast to the Lord; throughout your generations you are to celebrate it as a permanent ordinance.' <sup>21</sup> Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel and said to them, "Go and take for yourselves lambs according to your families, and slay the Passover lamb." <sup>22</sup> "You shall take a bunch of hyssop and dip it in the blood which is in the basin, and apply some of the blood that is in the basin to the lintel and the two doorposts; and none of you shall go outside the door of his house until morning." <sup>23</sup> "For the Lord will pass through to smite the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the Lord will pass over the door and will not allow the destroyer to come in to your houses to smite you. NASU

**John 10** <sup>9</sup> "I am the door; if anyone enters through Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture." <sup>10</sup> "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly. NASU

**John 1** <sup>29</sup> "...Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! NASU

**Revelation 12** <sup>11a</sup> "And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony... NASU

**Psalm 105** <sup>37</sup> At last, God freed all the Hebrews from their slavery and sent them away laden with the silver and gold of Egypt. And not even one was feeble on their way out! TPT

**Psalm 78** <sup>41</sup> Again and again they limited God, preventing him from blessing them... <sup>42</sup> They forgot his great love, how he took them by his hand, and *with redemption's kiss* he delivered them from their enemies. TPT

**2. Joshua 5** <sup>2</sup> At that time the Lord said to Joshua, "Make for yourself flint knives and circumcise again the sons of Israel the second time." <sup>8</sup> Now when they had finished circumcising all the nation, they remained in their places in the camp until they were healed." <sup>9</sup> Then the Lord said to Joshua, "Today I have rolled away the reproach (shame and disgrace) of Egypt from you." So the name of that place is called Gilgal to this day. <sup>10</sup> While the sons of Israel camped at Gilgal they observed the Passover on the evening of the fourteenth day of the month on the desert plains

**of Jericho.** <sup>11</sup> **On the day after the Passover, on that very day, they ate some of the produce of the land,** unleavened cakes and parched grain. <sup>12</sup> **The manna ceased on the day after they had eaten some of the produce of the land,** so that the sons of Israel no longer had manna, but they ate some of the yield of the land of Canaan during that year. NASU

**Joshua 6** <sup>15</sup> Then on the seventh day they rose early at the dawning of the day and marched around the city in the same manner seven times; only on that day they marched around the city seven times. <sup>16</sup> At the seventh time, when the priests blew the trumpets, Joshua said to the people, "**Shout! For the Lord has given you the city.**" <sup>19</sup> **But all the silver and gold and articles of bronze and iron are holy to the Lord; they shall go into the treasury of the Lord.**" NASU

**Proverbs 13** <sup>22b</sup> ...**And the wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous.** NASU

**3. Matthew 26** <sup>1</sup> When Jesus had finished all these words, He said to His disciples, <sup>2</sup> "You know that after two days the **Passover** is coming, and **the Son of Man is to be handed over for crucifixion.**" <sup>26</sup> While they were eating, Jesus took some bread, and after a blessing, He broke it and gave it to the disciples, and said, "Take, eat; this is My body." <sup>27</sup> And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you;" <sup>28</sup> for **this is My blood of the covenant,** which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins. NASU

**John 19** <sup>17</sup> They took Jesus, therefore, and He went out, bearing His own cross, to the place called the Place of a Skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha. <sup>18</sup> There they crucified Him, and with Him two other men, one on either side, and Jesus in between. <sup>34</sup> But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and **immediately blood and water came out.** NASU

**Matthew 28** <sup>6</sup> "**He is not here, for He has risen, just as He said.** Come, see the place where He was lying. NASU

**Galatians 3** <sup>9</sup> So then **those who are of faith are blessed with Abraham, the believer.** <sup>13</sup> Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us — for it is written, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS ON A TREE" — <sup>14</sup> **in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles,** so that we would receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. NASU

**1 Peter 2** <sup>24</sup> and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for **by His wounds you were healed.** NASU

**2 Corinthians 8** <sup>9</sup> For you have experienced the extravagant grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that although he was infinitely rich, he impoverished himself for our sake, **so that by his poverty, we could become rich beyond measure.** TPT

**Ephesians 2** <sup>4</sup> But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, <sup>5</sup> even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), <sup>6</sup> **and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,** NASU
